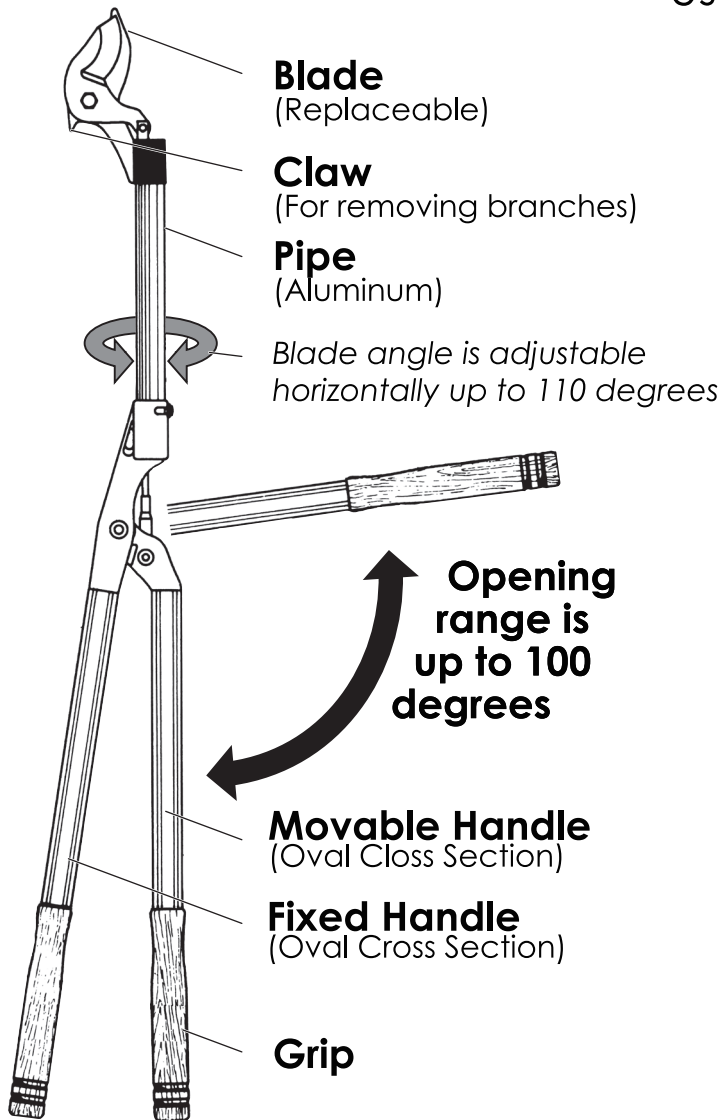


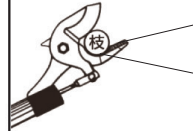
FUTOMARU

Use: Dedicated to branch lopping



TIPS

How to cut



This part is not for cut.

Locate a branch deep inside the mouth.



Diagonal cut is recommended to reduce resistance of cutting.

Maintenance



Clear sap, resin and residues.

Then oil the indicated parts by arrow.

WARNING

Safety Instruction

- These shears are dedicated to branch cutting. Use them only for their intended purpose.
- Keep away from electricity. This product is made of metal and is not insulated against electric shock. Approaching or contacting electric power lines with this product **may cause death or serious body injury by electrocution.** **Electricity can move through branches, especially if they are wet.**
- Keep shears away from children and people around you, when you use the tool.
- Dress properly. Wear hard hat, safety goggles, face and ear protection item and gloves to reduce the risk of personal injury.
- Make sure you always have good footing. Do not use Futomaru in an unstable places such as roof and the top of horse.

Precaution

- Futomaru is a shear dedicated to lopping branches. Do not cut the branches exceed the upper limit of cutting capacity of each Futomaru. **Lopping over the limit may cause breaks.**
- Once holding branches, **don't try to pry.** **That may cause blade chipping and deformation.**

Maintenance

- Use plant oil to screw parts on the blade.
- Keep the cutting tool sharp. When the blade becomes dull, use a sharpener, or replace it. Replacement blades are available.

Storage

- Close the mouth of the tool and keep it in safe place and tool should be out of the reach of children and other unauthorized persons.
